On 06/04/1981, an unidentified black female was recovered at the Richmond City Waste Treatment Plant in Richmond, VA. She is described as approximately 5'0" tall, weighing 110-120 pounds, with black, shorter than collar length hair. The female was wearing a maroon terry cloth skirt, black bra, and a long black sock. She had a hysterectomy and a bilateral salpingo-oophorectomy. On the inside of her right forearm was a tattoo that says "D.R." or "O.R." (see picture above). Investigators are asking anyone with information regarding this case or identification of the victim to contact them.
