On April 4, 2011, the skeletal remains of an unknown Asian male were discovered near Ocean Parkway, east of Gilgo Beach in Babylon, NY. The victim was found in women's clothing and may have worn it as part of their daily life. The cause of death was identified as a Homicide, and the date of death is estimated to be at least five years before the victim's discovery.
